



WHAT IS CROSS-REGISTRATION?

Four Cross College Alliance colleges offer students greater learning opportunities through cross-registration. [New College of Florida](#), [Ringling College of Art and Design](#), [State College of Florida](#) and [USF Sarasota-Manatee](#) want to enhance and increase your access to courses and curriculum not available at your home campus. Cross-registration allows eligible students to enroll in one course at a participating institution each fall and spring semester on a space-available basis under the program.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

- Students must be a full-time degree-seeking student during the term they apply for cross registration
 - Students are not eligible during their first term at their home institution
 - Students must be in good academic standing at their home institution
 - International students must meet all documentation requirements of the host institution.
